


Review of Republic of Ireland Subsistence Allowances - Overnight

The Joint Secretaries of the Joint Negotiating Council have agreed to the revision of the overnight subsistence allowance for the Republic of Ireland as outlined in the attached appendix.


The new rates are based on the Civil Service Schedule of Overnight Provision for the Republic of Ireland and take effect from 1 January 2000.


Overnight subsistence allowance covers the overnight absence of up to 24 hours. The separate NJC day subsistence allowances shall be paid in respect of the excess hours incurred after a period of 24 hours attracting night subsistence allowance has elapsed.

NIGHT SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCES – REPUBLIC OF IRELAND

WITH EFFECT FROM 1 JANUARY 2000

CLASS A
(Admin. Officer – Chief Executive)

CLASS B
(All other Officers)

(a flat rate allowance covering accommodation and meals for a 24 hour period).

Elsewhere

Actual Expenditure plus £4.00, i.e., officers may claim the actual cost (supported by receipts) of bed, breakfast, lunch and dinner plus an allowance of £4.00 towards the cost of travel between hotel and detached duty station.

In addition, the overseas personal expenses allowance of £5.15 may be claimed for each 24 hour period for which night subsistence allowance is payable.
